Career and Technical Education at NAU will be offering 500-level credit to educators attending and participating in the 2018 ACTEAZ Conference! The 3-credit course could be used in an undergraduate or graduate program. It might also be able to be used for teacher certification or recertification. NAU has Career and Technical Education undergraduate and graduate degrees that may be of interest. Our Bachelor's of Education, CTE and Masters in CTE degrees are online. Up to 55 hours of occupational experience credit is available for the BSED CTE degree.

**CTE 593 In-service Teacher Workshop: Contemporary Instructional Applications
(Summer Session 07/23/2018 - 08/7/2018, Hampton) Register for Class number 1760**

This 3-credit hour class is graded (i.e. A, B, C). Requirements include:

- Attend and participate in the 2018 ACTEAZ Conference; Provide proof of registration and attendance (such as a copy of your receipt and nametag).
- Provide a written agenda/synopsis (organized by day) listing all the conference related activities in which you took part. This would include general sessions, workshops, tours, networking sessions, luncheons, vendor exhibits, etc. You will need to participate in 45 hours of conference related activities to receive the 3 credit hours. Alternative assignments available to "make up" contact hours to meet the 45 hour requirement if necessary. Please contact the instructor for options – these can be completed prior to or after the conference. Specific requirements for the agenda/synopsis will be provided in the course syllabus.
- Write a 3 page reflective paper (specific requirements will be provided in the course syllabus) on what you learned and how you will use the information from the conference
- Complete either option 1 OR option 2 below:
 - Option 1: Write detailed lesson plans that encompass two weeks of instruction that you can use in your classroom next school year that incorporate information you received at the conference (lesson plan format information will be provided in the course syllabus). You do not have to write one two week lesson plan - you can turn in lesson plans in any combination that equal two weeks of instruction.
 - Option 2: Given the information you identified in your reflective paper, write a detailed professional action plan (min. 3 pages, no specific format required) for the application of information you received at the conference. Your action plan must include SMART objectives with timelines within a year.
- Submit all information to instructor by August 7, 2018
