## 2022 Summer Agricultural Institute (SAI)

SAI will be offered June 13 - June 16, 2022 and will be offered in a hybrid format. One-day virtual will be offered on Monday, June 13th, 2022 and three days of in-person tours will be held June 14th - 16th. In person tours will take place in Yavapai, Pima, and Maricopa Counties and will visit local agricultural industries.

SAI is designed to teach K-12 teachers about food and fiber production and help them incorporate that knowledge in the classroom curriculum. SAI combines hands-on learning about agriculture with practical curriculum development. Participants who complete SAI will receive a certificate indicating the earning of 20 professional development hours. Participants also have the option to earn up to three undergraduate or graduate level credits through the Department of Agricultural Education, Technology and Innovation at the University of Arizona.
