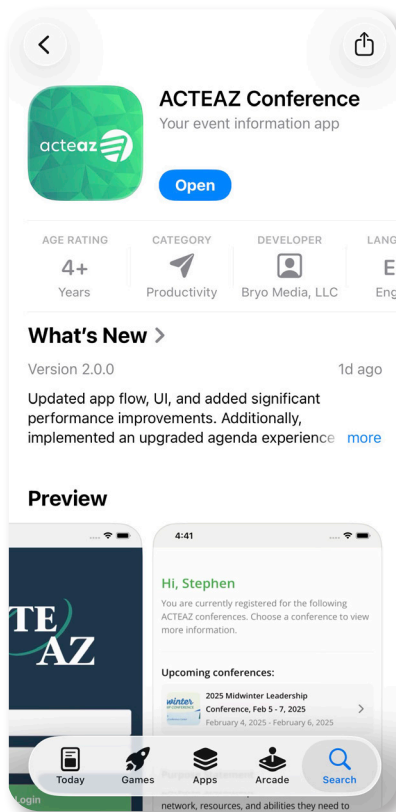
# Download and Install

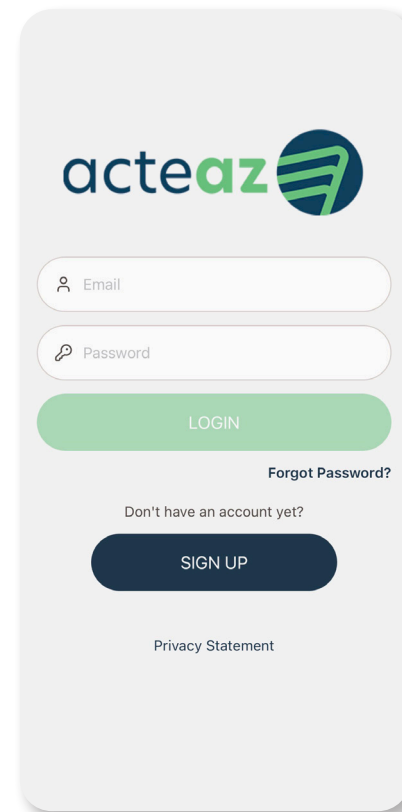
Once downloaded, log-in using the same email and password you used to register for the conference.

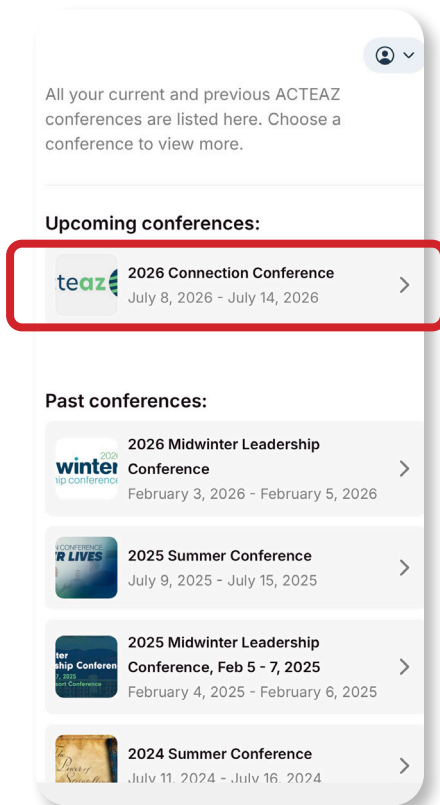

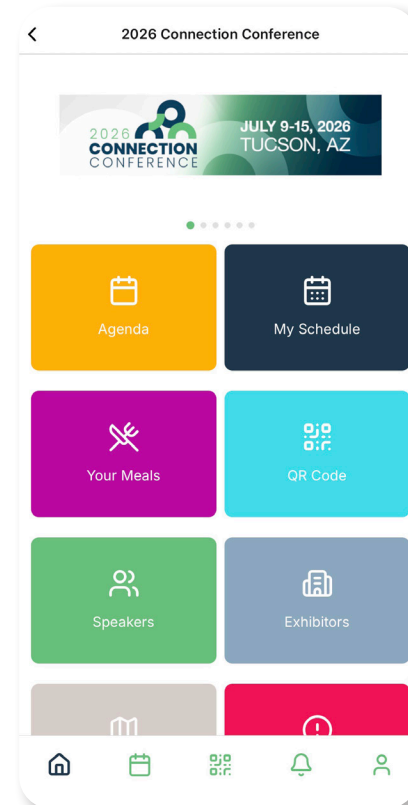

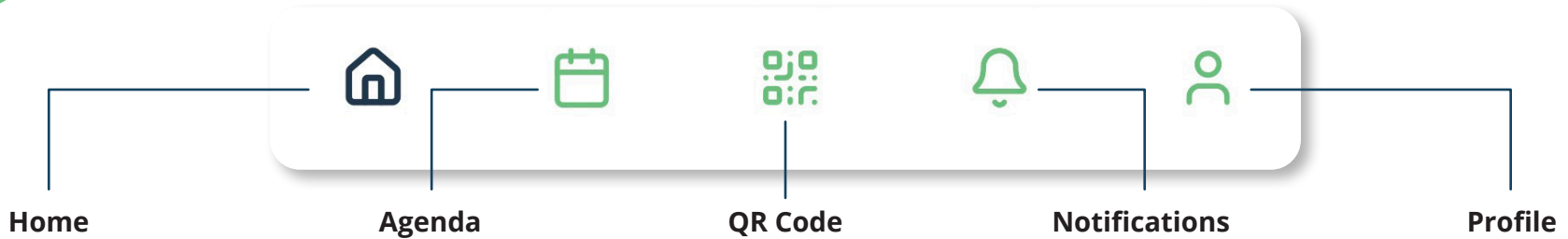

# Bottom Navigation Bar



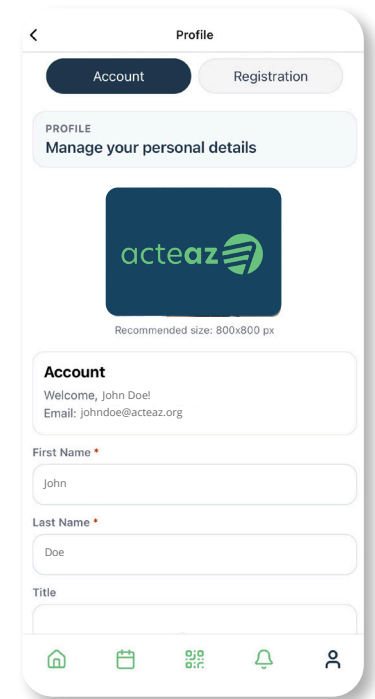
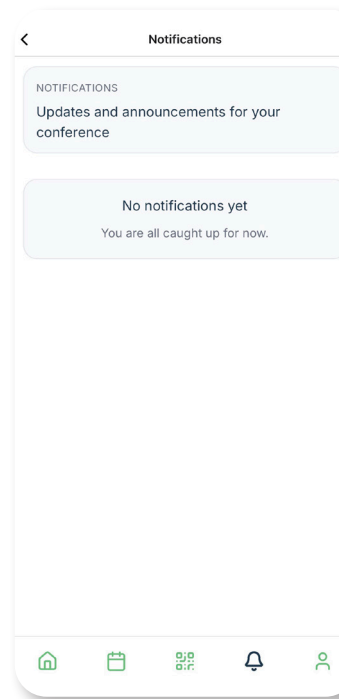
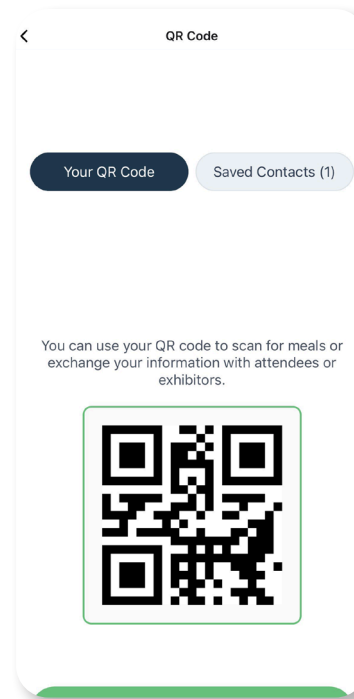
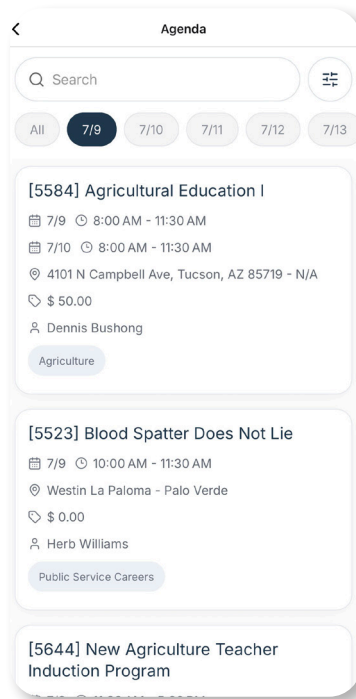
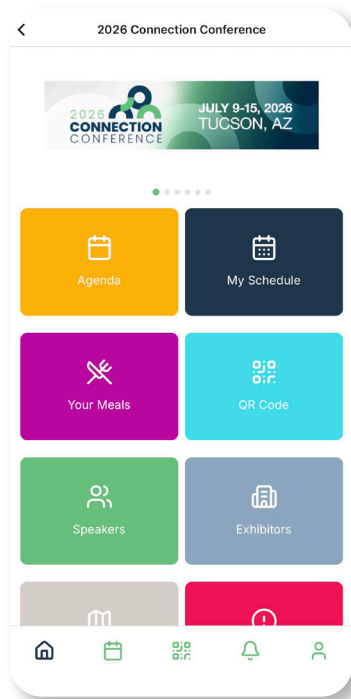
The homepage gives you access to all features in the app.

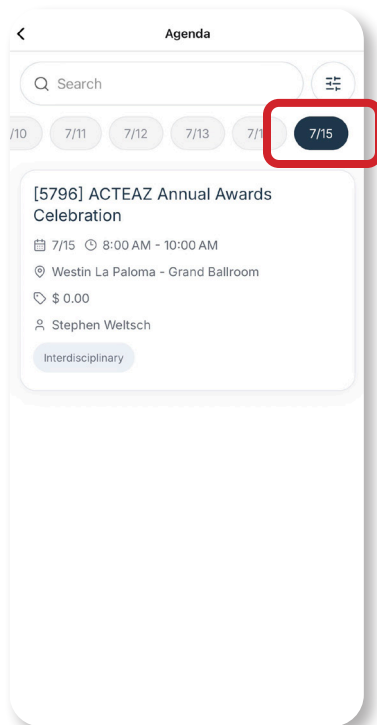


Agenda

The Agenda lists all sessions for the selected day, including the time, location, cost, and speaker.

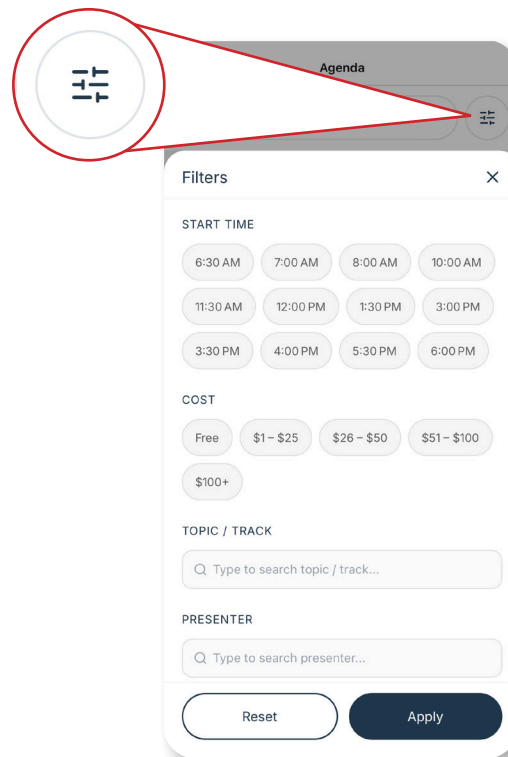

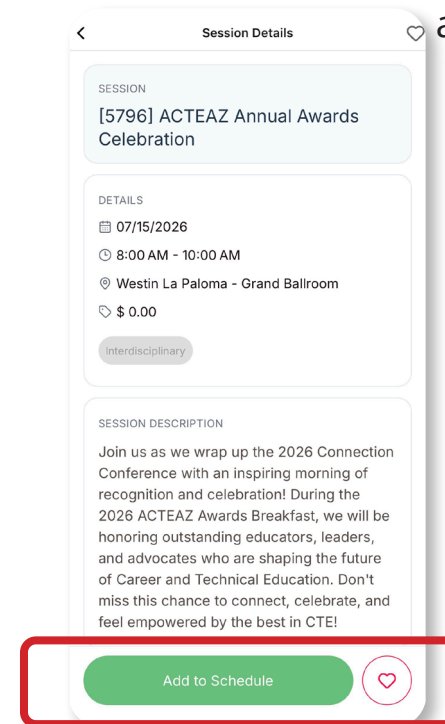

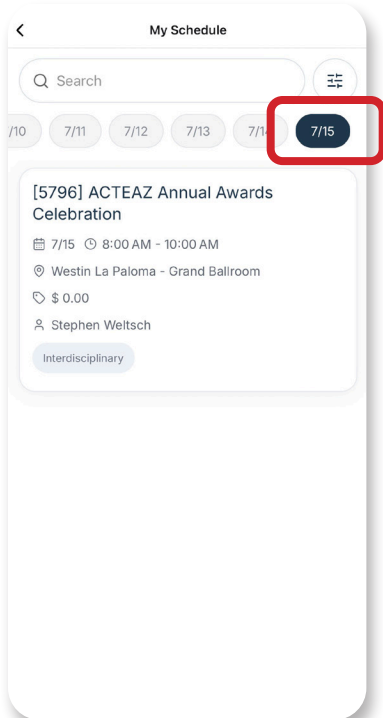


My Schedule

My Schedule displays all the No-cost, Premium, and Invite-only sessions you've selected for each day.

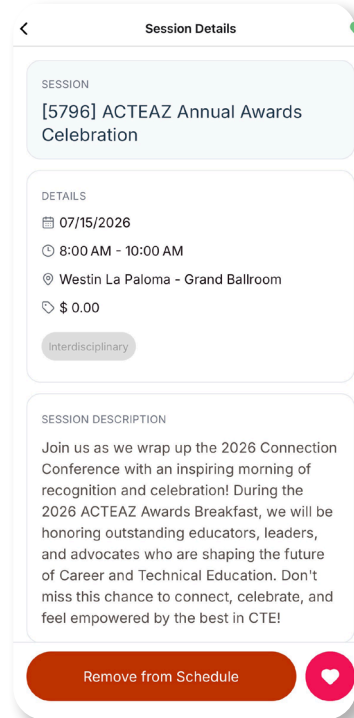

Select a specific date to view the sessions saved for that day.



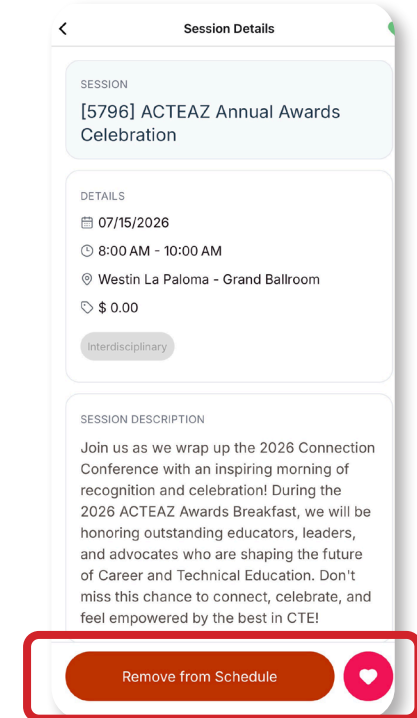

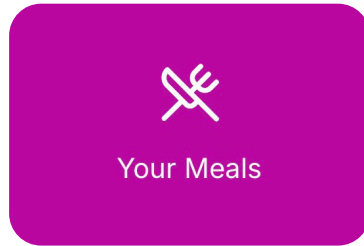

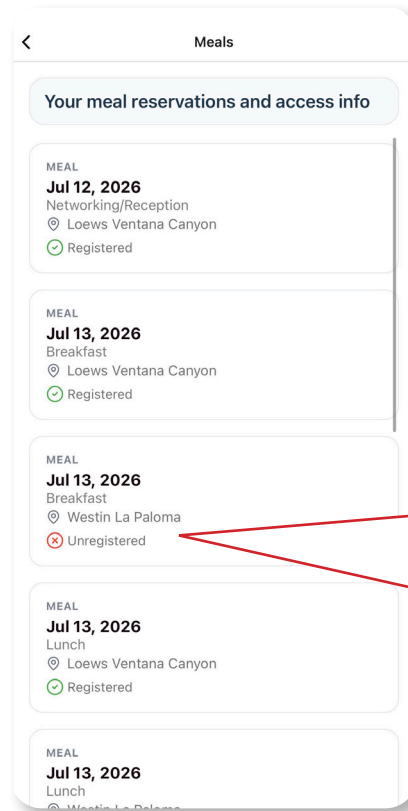
To remove a session from your schedule, click "Remove from Schedule."

Your Meals lists which meals you are registered for each day of the conference. This includes the event and location for each meal.

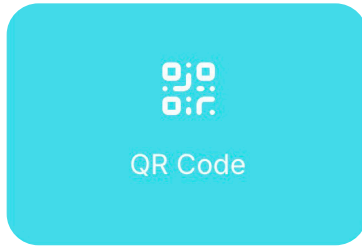


If you have a meal selected at one conference hotel, the same meal at the other conference hotel will show a red circled "X" and be marked "unregistered".

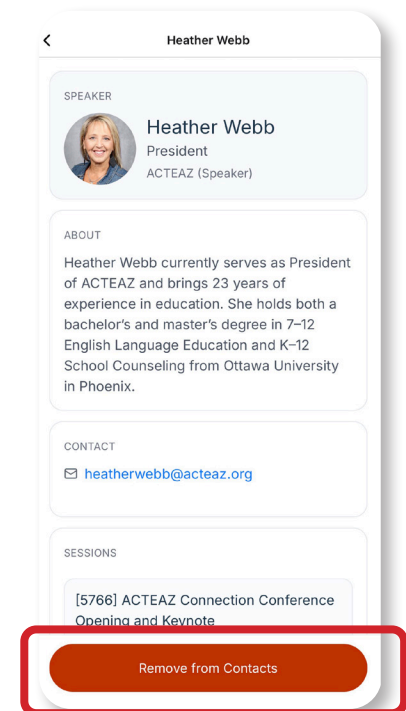
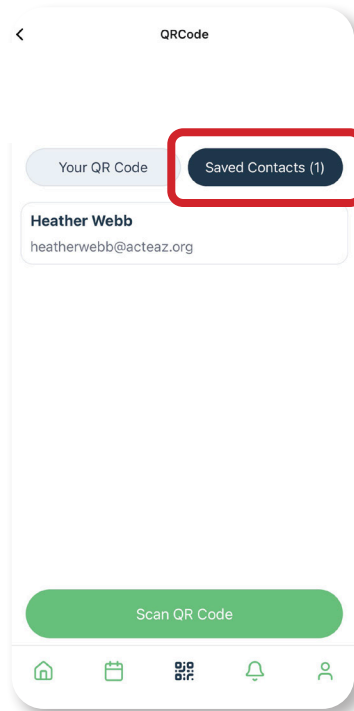
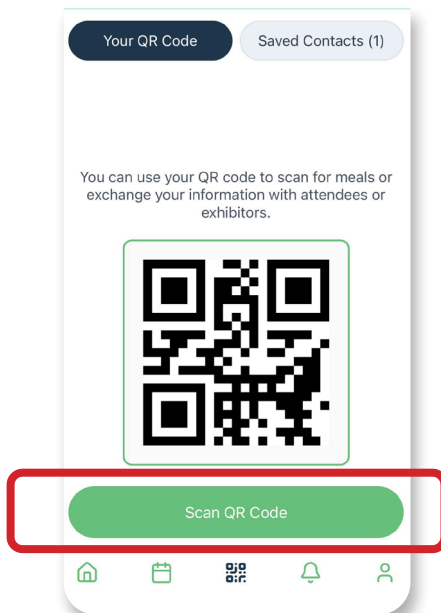


The QR Code lets you scan for meals, exchange information with attendees or exhibitors, and save contacts. It also allows attendees to save your contact information.

**3** Select "Remove from Contacts" to remove that individual from your contacts.



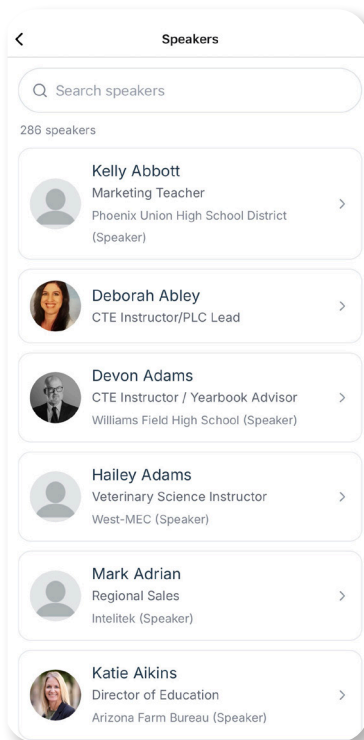

Speakers shows the list of speakers who are presenting.

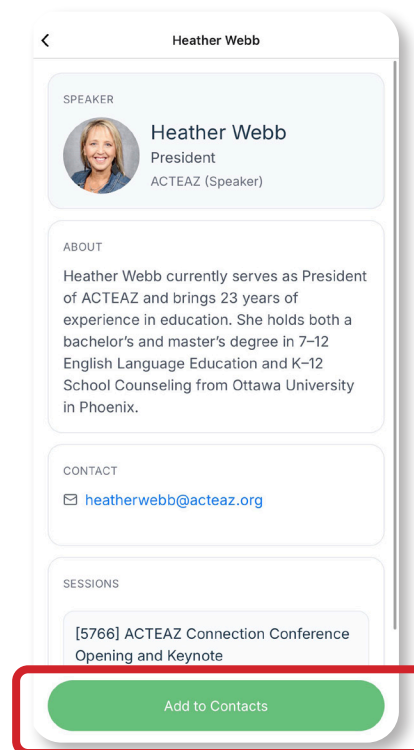

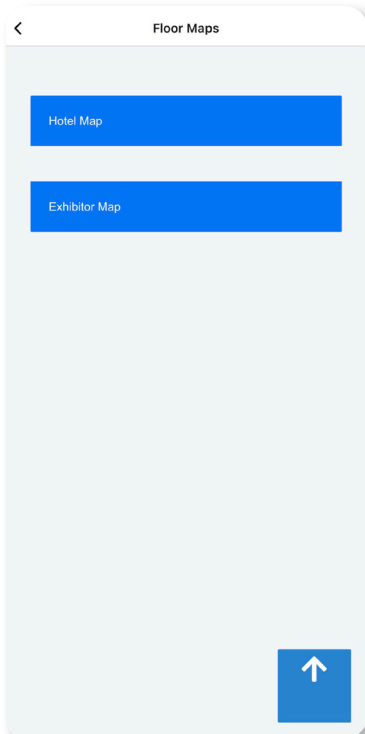


Floor Maps

Floor Maps includes the Hotel Maps and Exhibitor Maps for both hotels.

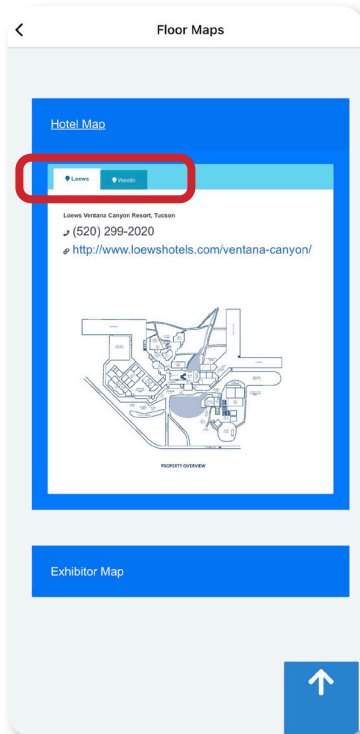

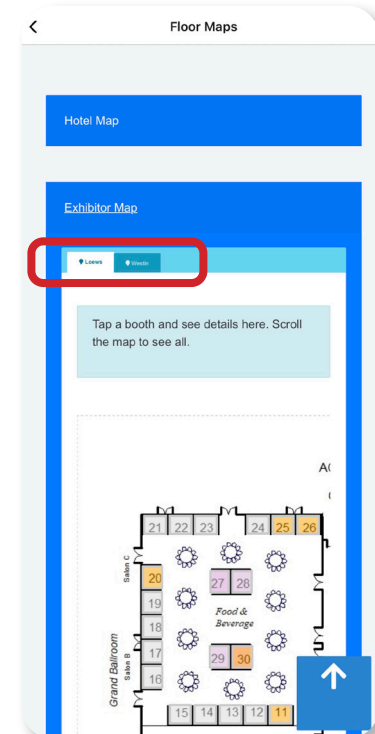
